Christmas Lunch – Wednesday 14 December

On Wednesday 14 December, students will have the opportunity to enjoy our annual Christmas lunch in the dining rooms. This will cost £3 and will include a main course of a full Christmas dinner (meat and vegetarian options available) and a dessert. Students on Free School Meals can have a main course **and** either a dessert **or** a drink.

If students do not want to have the Christmas meal, there will be a small selection of hot/cold food available, or they can bring their packed lunch as normal.

KS3, KS4 and KS5 students are encouraged to donate non-perishable food items and toiletries to be sent to Ivybridge Link, a foodbank in our local community. Essential food items required by the foodbank include:

TOILETRIES & HOUSEHOLD ITEMS (PRIORITY)

Shampoo, conditioner, body wash, soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, sanitary pads/tampons, deodorant, toilet paper, washing up liquid, antibacterial wipes, laundry detergent, multipurpose spray, nappies, baby wipes, baby food, baby formula.

FOOD

Tinned soup, cereal, baked beans, tinned tomatoes, tinned fruits, tinned peas, tinned chickpeas, tinned beans, tinned meat / spam, tinned meal, cooking sauce, rice, pasta, pasta sauce, sugar, tea, coffee, long life milk, jam/spread, biscuits, squash/juice.

Please ensure that all goods donated are in date.

The food donations made by students will be collected by their Form Tutors, House & Citizenship Ambassadors and Senior House Ambassadors during morning registration, on the days specified above.

Christmas Jumper Day – Wednesday 14 December

Students are allowed wear a Christmas jumper to school on **Wednesday 14 December**. Donations are not compulsory - however, if you are able to do so, you can donate to Save the Children directly [via their website](#).
