### Etymology and historical meaning of the term **summit**:

late Middle English (in the general sense 'top part'): from Old French *somete*, from *som* 'top', from Latin *summum*, neuter of *summus* 'highest'.

**Adjective:** annual, regular, crisis

**Verb:** call, convene, have

**Noun:** conference, meeting, talks

**Preposition:** at the summit, summit **between**, summit in...
