Expansion proposal for Isleworth and Syon School

The London Borough of Hounslow is working with local schools and Academies to establish a comprehensive programme of secondary expansion to meet the challenge of providing an additional 29 forms of entry by 2019.

Some of the growth is expected to be met by pending Free School applications, but whatever the outcome of these, substantial elements of the programme will need to be met through the expansion of existing schools. Exact timing will depend upon Free School announcements in March 2015, but plans are being made to ensure the Isleworth and Syon project could be delivered by September 2017.

Isleworth and Syon has been identified as a priority school for expansion, based upon its location, performance, and popularity. The school has undertaken a significant exercise in master-planning, and has a clear vision of a coherent phased development of the site.

Allocation from LBH controlled 'basic need' funding will need to link with CIF funding in order for the expansion programme to properly address significant condition issues.
