**Year 11 Raising Standards Evening  
Tuesday 31 March 2020 – 6.00pm**

After the Easter break, there are only three school weeks until the start of the main written examination season. We have scheduled an additional evening for students and families (lasting a maximum of 45 minutes) to support you in the 'final push'.
