Important Information – On-Site Education Provision

In line with government advice, the school has remained open. However, the new self-isolation measures announced on Tuesday have had a significant impact on our staffing.

It is with regret that I have to put in the arrangements below to cope with these new pressures.

Thursday 19 March 2020

YEARS 7, 8, 9 & 10

Students should attend school for a normal morning of lessons. Lunch will be available for all students, and then these **students will be dismissed at 1.30pm.**

YEARS 11, 12 & 13

Students should attend school for their normal timetabled lessons. Lunchtime will be slightly compressed and these **students will leave school at 2.40pm.**

Friday 20 March 2020

All students in Years 7-13 should attend school for a normal morning of lessons as per the timetable. Lunch will be available for all students, and then all **students will be dismissed at 1.30pm.**

Monday 23 March 2020 – School Closed to Students

From Monday, the school will be closed to students, until such time as the spread of the COVID-19 virus has passed its peak and it is safe for all members of the school community to return.

Our staff are ready to continue to provide education through our online platforms and the students will be given further specific instructions during the next two days.

From Monday, please do try to create a daily routine that enables your son/ward to get into the habit of continuing with their school timetable from home.

I do hope that you appreciate the circumstances and challenging times that we face, and the reasons for our decisions. It is important that you follow school communications on the school website as we anticipate that there will be more information issued in the next few days.
