## **Level 2 Results Day – Thursday 12 August 2021**

I do hope that you and your families are well.

It has been great to see the good work so many of you have been doing since face-to-face teaching finished. For those of you planning to join our Sixth Form, you know that this is compulsory work and will be addressed at your induction interview.

### **Level 2 Results Day, Thursday 12 August - Arrangements**

We are planning to issue results to you face-to-face. Results will be issued to students in small groups. Timeslots are only 10 minutes apart so students need to ensure they are outside reception at the allocated time. You will not be permitted in if you arrive at a different time slot and will have to wait until later in the day. Students arriving too early will be asked to exit the site and return at the allocated time.

Your timeslot has been emailed to you.

On arrival, you will need to enter the school through the main reception.

If you are unable to collect your results in person, a parent/carer can collect them for you as long as you:

- Agree in writing beforehand with an email to [rculling@isleworthsyon.org](mailto:rculling@isleworthsyon.org); and
- Ensure they bring proof of identity.

We cannot provide results by email or over the phone. Any results not collected will be posted first class that afternoon.

### **Post-Results Services**

Attached to this email is the important information to explain the appeals process available to students this summer. There will also be an autumn examination series for students who may wish to retake any subjects. Any further support issued for students and parents/carers before Results Day will be messaged on Teams and uploaded to our website.

### **Next Steps & The Sixth Form**

As previously stated, the over-riding priority at this stage of your education is ensuring that you can move on to the next stage of your education or employment. This remains our primary consideration and whatever your final grades, members of staff will be on-site to support you with your next steps.
