Year 10 Statistics Examination

I am writing to inform you that your son/ward will be taking a mock statistics examination on **Monday 9 May**. The exam will cover all topics in the GCSE statistics curriculum that have been taught this year. A detailed revision list is available on SharePoint and will be distributed on Teams by your son/ward's teacher.

Most of the exams will take place in the normal teaching room but, depending on your son/ward's class, they may be asked to go to a different room.

Students are to head to their exam location immediately at the end of lunch, to ensure that the 1 hour 30minute examination starts on time. The exam is due to finish by 3.15pm.

Your son/ward will require the following equipment for the examination, none will be provided on the day:

- Pen
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Rubber
- Calculator

This is an internal exam in preparation for the final GCSE being sat this summer. The results of this examination will be used to determine the final topics covered by teachers in the build up to their final GCSE assessments, so please encourage them to revise for this assessment.

As a reminder the sittings for the actual examinations for GCSE Statistics are:

- Tuesday 19 June 2022 (afternoon exam)
- Friday 24 June 2022 (morning exam)
