### 'New To You' – Uniform, Kit, and Resource Donations

# I.&S NEW TO YOU

We are delighted to launch a new initiative in order to provide a facility for families to purchase pre-used items of school uniform or sports kit that are in a reasonable condition. This will support our efforts to recycle and to prevent waste and will allow us to provide a service where not every purchase from the school shop needs to be of brand-new items.

We will accept all items of school uniform (blazers, shirts, trousers, ties and jumpers) and sports kit (school games and house tops, school shorts and red football socks), as long as the items are in a reasonable condition.

We will also accept school shoes, football boots and trainers which your son/ward may have outgrown, and revision books and any textbooks that may be worth passing on to another student.

#### How can I donate?

All items of uniform/kit that are still in reasonable or good condition, can be donated to the school. To do so, please ensure:

- That the items are in at least reasonable condition.
- That the items have been washed.
- That the items are bagged and with your name attached.
- Donations can be made by dropping the bags off at reception (even during the school holidays) or by asking your son/ward to deliver the items to the school office.

Other materials, e.g. revision books, can also be delivered to school in the same way.

#### How can I make a purchase?

Once we have processed the items and built up a stock, the donations will be listed on [Scopay](#). You will be able to check whether items are in stock by going to the site.

- Orders can be made in the usual way by going to the 'New to You' section on Scopay.
- We will ask you to make a donation for the purchase and suggest the following prices:
  - Blazers £5; school trousers £3; school ties and white shirts £1.
  - Games shirts, house polos and shorts £3, each item.
  - Red games socks £1.
  - Football boots / trainers - individually priced.
  - School shoes - individually priced.
