Level 3 Results Day – Thursday 18 August 2022

We are sure you are delighted that the examination period has come to an end. We hope that you can now enjoy a well-deserved break.

Results Day Arrangements

The school will be open from 8.30 - 11.00am for you to collect your examination results, as well as receive advice and guidance on your next steps. Any uncollected results will be sent home by first-class post later on the afternoon of 18 August.

If a student is unable to attend in person, you can arrange, in advance, for someone else to collect them. You must inform Mrs Culling in writing, via email: rculling@isleworthsyon.org. The chosen person will need to bring a photographic proof of identity on the day. Please note that we cannot provide results by email or over the phone.

Any Year 13 student who re-took GCSE examinations can collect their results on Thursday 25 August between 10.00am and 12 noon.

Post-Results Services

Examination boards offer a range of post-results services. These include seeing your examination script or requesting a review of results for the examination(s) if marks are close to the next grade up. Priority services are available to students whose university places may depend on the outcome of a review of marking; the deadline for this is Thursday 25 August. There are fees associated with these services which are payable by students. You will be able to discuss these with Mrs Culling on Results Day.

Examination Certificates

These will arrive in school during November - we will inform you by email when they arrive. Schools are advised not to post certificates home as they are important documents. You must, therefore, collect your certificates from school in person by the end of January 2023. After that time, any uncollected certificates will be destroyed and you will have to order and pay for replacements from the examination boards. The current charge is approximately £40.00 per certificate.
