

- Normal timetable:** students who are working outside their normal classroom (at home, within the school library, The Link or within the Inclusion Room) are asked to follow their normal schedule timetable on a daily basis. Students are asked to complete the work outlined below unless their individual class teacher has Teams messaged / emailed alternative, bespoke arrangements.
- Priority work:** Students must complete the activities below in the order listed as they have been prioritised. The hyperlinks are all connected to the appropriate subject sites.
 - If students are unable to find the appropriate lesson then they must check the PLC and / or SharePoint for the relevant subject content. Every student should know the unit title as well as the location of the PLC.
 - If this fails, students should Teams message their class teacher on Class Voice using polite, formal standard English.
 - If this fails, students should visit the Oak National Academy website where they will find similar resources to those being used within their mainstream, normal lesson: [Key Stage 3 resources](#) and [Key Stage 4 resources](#).
- Work completion:** unless students have their exercise book, student must use ClassNoteBook to complete the classwork. All *evidence of work* must be completed and uploaded by the student to Class Notes within the subject Class Notebook. Save work in Class Notes using a general coding system: DATE, TITLE OF LESSON. For example, 10/10/20 Lord Of The Flies - essay. Any student working on an electronic device is able to record and submit their work directly within Class Notes.
- Notifying the teacher:** once students have completed their work they must message their class teacher on the Class Voice channel in MS Teams.
- Additional work:** students are reminded that there is an additional expectation to (a) check the INSIGHT App for PPA (homework); (b) read for 20 minutes every day and; (c) revise using [SAM Learning](#) or any other online platform.
- Learning recovery:** students who require catch-up resources can also use the [Oak National Academy](#) website. Liaise with your class teacher to identify gaps in knowledge; use the Oak National Academy video-clips to bridge these gaps. Review the PLC to monitor progress.
