Wider Learning Week 2023 Year 7 Day-by-Day Reminders

Ahead of WLW, please see below a reminder of the timetable and key points for what is sure to be an exciting and engaging week.

Key Points

- Canteen will be open as normal for on-site students.
- Full school uniform should be worn, and equipment brought as normal.
- Students are allowed to wear plain black trainers for their House Day visit.
- Students will need to wear their school PE Kit (House top) to school on whichever day they are participating in Battle Day and Police Day.
- A packed lunch (FSM students will be provided with one), as well as a bottle of water and suncream needed for House Day visits.
- Students will be meeting in different rooms each day these will be displayed on screens around the school, so they need to check when they arrive each morning.
