THE FIRST STEPS TO YOUR FUTURE IN TEACHING

As a successful applicant, you will be offered an induction visit to your placement school to prepare you for the start of your course in September.

Throughout the academic year, your central training will take place on Wednesdays at the University of Roehampton. For the remaining four days of each week you will be developing your practice in your placement school where you will be assigned a trained subject mentor and supervised by a professional coordinating mentor. You will also have a subject specialist tutor from Roehampton University.

In the spring term you will benefit from a contrastive teaching placement at one of our other partner schools.

All of our partner schools have comprehensive intakes and you will gain experience of working with young people from all backgrounds and abilities. You will also have access to post-16 learners in at least one of your placements, if you are on an 11-16 programme; as well as some KS3 experience if on a 14 -19 programme.
